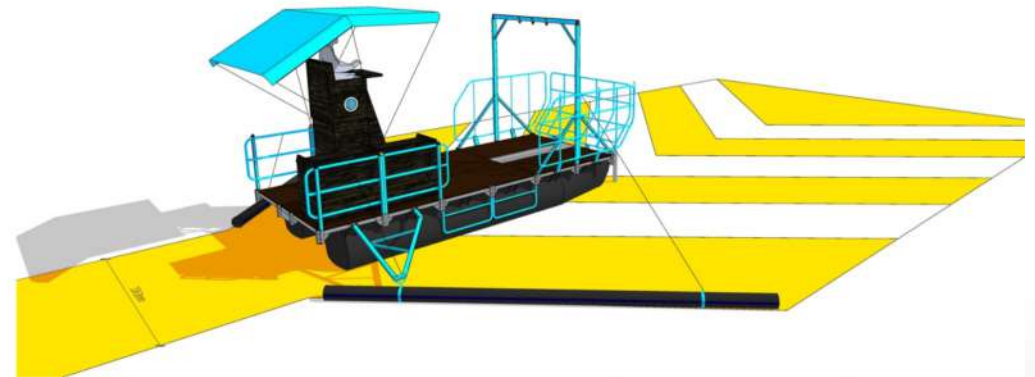
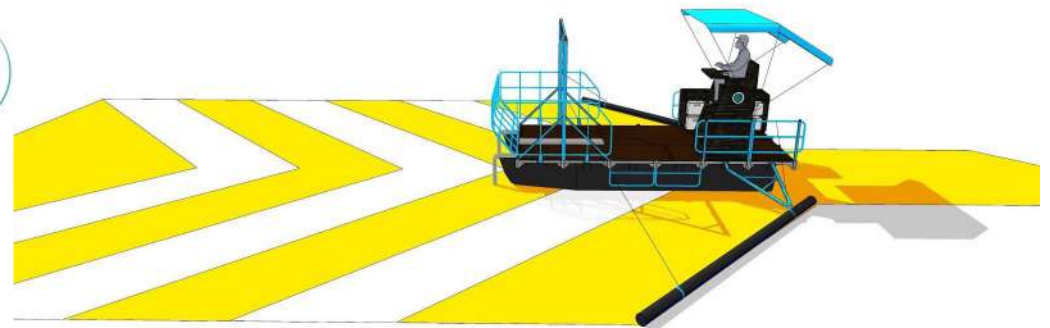

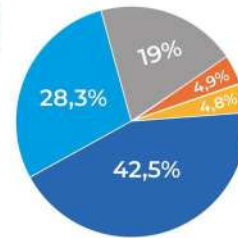
Professional river cleanup action on the Latorica river, in Ukraine. The plastics are collected separately from driftwood.



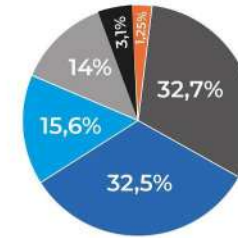


Professional river cleanup action on the Bodrog river, in Hungary. The plastics are collected separately from driftwood.

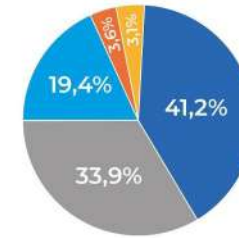

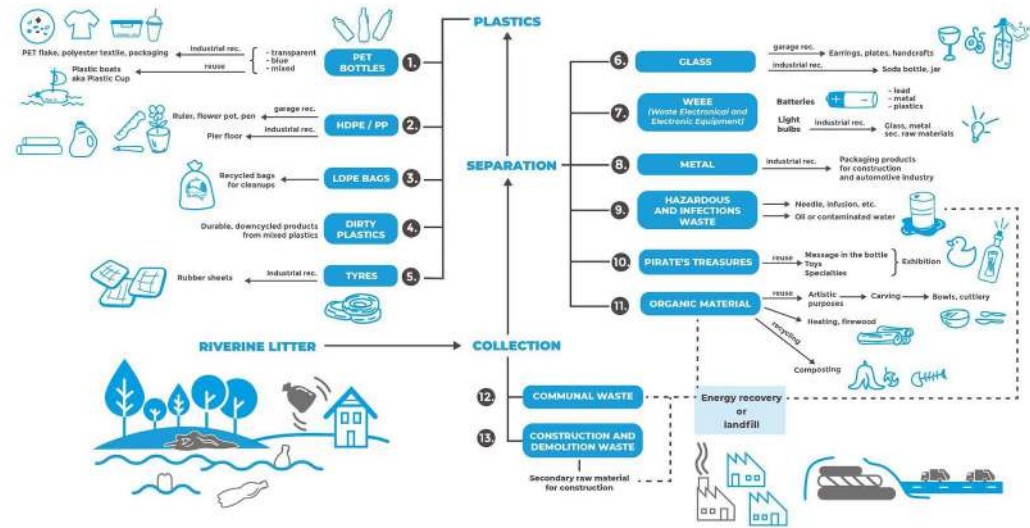

Workflow based on Plastic Cup's waste management practices.



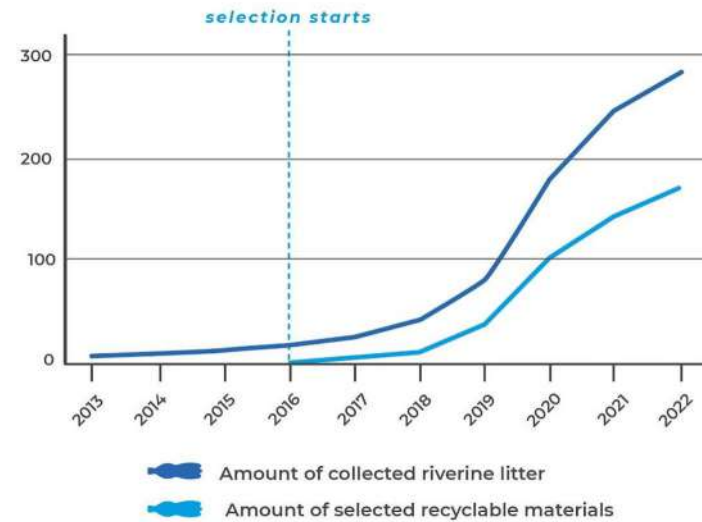

Selection of collected riverine litter in Becej, Serbia, after a successful community river cleanup action. Experience shows that based on the protocol provided by the Transnational River Cleanup Handguide, as much as 60% of the collected waste can be recycled.
